

V.A.C. Report 01/19/2010-02/15/2010

01-19 Vern Bagley delivered batteries from Belch's house to Nomad (Post 105) in West Phoenix to use in a power chair while he is convalescing.

01-19 Belch worked on power chairs.

01-20 Belch did more of the same.

01-20 Boon and Gary paid property taxes for a Vietnam Veteran with terminal lymphoma.

01-22 Belch obtained and installed heavy duty batteries in D9 power chair to take to "Bill", a Vietnam Veteran with Elephantiasis.

01-23,24 Boon, Vern, and Sylvia at gun show in Phoenix selling raffle tickets to support Project We Remember.

01-26 Boon and Belch delivered D9 power chair to Bill, picked up another power chair. Picked up electric range from Larry Palmby, picked up dinette set and class 2 hitch, picked up elliptical trainer in Gold Canyon, delivered to storage.

01-27 Belch and Althea picked up two more power chairs and one power scooter from Mesa and Apache Junction.

01-28 Boon and Belch met with Apache Junction Police Chief Monahan to let the City know that the V.A.C. is there for Veterans whenever the Patrol Officers or their Victims Assistance program find them.

01-28 D.A.V. commissioned Boon to build a rifle to raffle to raise funds. This project is underway.

01-31 Jim Gowing donated and delivered couch and chair to V.A.C.

02-01 Boon and Mark Ledoux loaded furniture and furnishings for a Project We Remember apartment in Tuscon.

02-03 Boon delivered a custom case for military medals to the City of Mesa. Ceremonies to dedicate this are pending.

02-03 Belch set up P.A. for the Four Chaplains Ceremony, took John Menefee to 2 Dr's appointments in Scottsdale.

02-04 Boon and Gary delivered numerous clothing, backpacks, sleeping bags, etc. to Stand Down for Homeless Veterans.

02-06 Boon had a meeting with the Marine Corps League and presented them with a flintlock rifle to raffle.

02-10 Belch ran diagnostic tests on power chairs, then delivered three of them to storage out of his living room.
